2.1 Rural Roads

Jharkhand State Rural Roads Development Authority (JSRRDA) has already been constituted in the state for better management of "Rural Connectivity Programme" especially PMGSY. This important organ needs capacity building. The services of qualified professionals are proposed to be obtained by outsourcing or hiring on contract basis. Regular training

will be undertaken to keep the personnel abreast with latest knowledge in the field.
