ANNUAL PLAN - 2010 - 2011

INTRODUCTION

The Department aims, on one hand to promote the sports & other youth activities to harness the youth power of excellence character, on the other hand it is also responsible for preserving and promoting the tremendous diversity and richness of cultural heritage and ethics of the State. These twin tracks of mental and bodily characteristics focused for enriching the social, cultural and intellectual life of the youth of the state.

The state has a unique and glorious sporting tradition. Apart from being a great treasure of talent for archery, hockey, athletics, kho-kho and football. It was also home to the celebrated hockey wizard and captain of the first Olympic Gold winning Indian team at Amsterdam, Jaipal Singh Munda.

Sports & Youth Affairs

Different Games competitions are being organised from Panchayat to State level to promote sports. Infrastructure like playfields at the panchayat level and Block/District level stadiums are being constructed including in Ranchi a modern state of the art Mega Sports Complex of International standard is ready to host the 34th National Games to channelise the youth energy and development of Sports, the Government has approved Youth Policy & Sports Policy as well as sports equipments along with other facilities are being provided among B.P.L Youth. Participants at National/International Games are being ensured, so that youth can be inspired. Youth Festival is being organised for awareness among them to mobilize their positive energy. In the year 2007-08 438 medals has been won by the State sportsman, while in the year 2006-07 only 296 medals has been awarded. For this sake 22 Residential and 52 Day Boarding Centre is running at present. Birsa Munda Award, Jaipal Singh Award, Albert Ekka Award, Award in the name of Freedom Fighter has been started. CM Football tournament has been started from this year.

Arts & Culture

To preserve and to protect the ancient culture and monument of the State, several scheme and programme are in our hand. 159 Akhra and 86 Dumkuriya traditional centre has been formulated. Multipurpose cultural building has been constructed in the Hotwar, Ranchi.

Archaeology

Special survey has been constructed in the district Dumka, Saraikela for the purpose to identify ancient archaeological spots. Sutyambhe and Khukhragarh conservation works are going on. Archaeological workshop is also organised at the district and the state level.

Museum

In order to preserve the archaeological remains and cultural heritage, the departmental museum organizes social exhibition, seminar, lectures etc. in which the knowledge of students and common masses along with an awareness about the history of the state.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Sports & Youth Affairs

Jharkhand is a rising star in the field of Sports. Several of its players are now playing for the country, especially in the games of Hockey and Archery. Captain of Indian Cricket Team Mahendra Singh Dhoni is a dazzling star of the Jharkhandi horizon.

The Department mainly looks after the school games, Rural Games and Women Games directly and other games through extending financial assistance to Sports Organizations, is trying its best to promote sports all over the states.

- Publication of a book " Pratimayein" etc.

2. STATE SHARE TO CSS

2.1. National Service Scheme [7 : 5]

Under this scheme college students are motivated to participate in social work. This scheme is implemented through Universities/ colleges of the state. For this scheme central and state govt. sanction grants in the ratio of 7:5 respectively for two types of programmes -

- a. **Regular activities:** During these activities Rs. 160.00 is spent for each volunteers for regular N.S.S. activities.
- b. **Special Camps :** 50% of total strength of sanction N.S.S volunteers are selected for special camp and Rs. 300 is spent on each volunteer.
- c. Under NSS villages/tolas will be adopted and special programme will be organized.

2.2 PYKKA (Panchayat Yuva Khel Kud Abhiyan) {75:25}

This scheme will be planned to conduct the sports in Rural areas, where the department promotes various sports activities. Panchayat Yuva Kida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) will be conducted in blocks and district level. PYKKA is being planned from this budgeting year. This scheme is being proposed to promote young sports persons in rural areas of the State.

Under Panchayat Yuva Kida Aur Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) scheme, with a view to ensuring Sports development as an integral aspect of youth development and youth development as critical to accelerated National development, the National Sports Policy 2001 lays Special emphasis on "Board basis of sports" through grassroots level sports activity and " promoting excellence in sports" at the National and International levels. It is therefore, essential that sports developments is given adequate thrust so that it could permeate through other aspects of social life and make the youth health conscious, positive and productive.

Under the scheme, financial assistance shall be given to a village/ Block Panchayat for the following Purpose:

- **One-time capital grant-** for development of sports infrastructure. Financial pattern will be contributed.
- **Annual acquisition grant** - for a period of five years for acquisition of sports equipment, accessories, support fixtures, consumables and repair and maintenance.
- **Annual operational grant** - for a period of five years to meet operational expenses of non competition activities, including honorarium to Kridashree, Maintenance of Infrastructure etc.

- **Annual competition grant** - for organising tournaments at the block level and the district level.
- **Prize money** - to village Panchayats securing first three positions at the annual block level tournament and to block Panchayats securing first three positions in the annual district level tournament.

3. STATE PLAN SCHEMES

Continuing Schemes

Sports and Youth Affairs

3.1. Sports Welfare Fund / Stipend / Honour

The department tries best to help the needy sports person in distress such as illness or any other need of such types. We are also planning for the life/Medical insurance and rehabilitation. Fund is provided for those injured players or athletes, who are receiving training in residential/Day Boarding Sports centers. The deptt. has already invited application from different ex-sports person/current sports person for the sports welfare fund.

We provided the financial help to 134 sports person on the basis of their achievements, who is accepted to win medal for the state, will be provided stipend up to Rs. 500 to 6000 per month, which is under circular of sports stipend. We also reward the sports person on the basis of their National & International achievements.

3.2 Sports Training Center/ Talent Hunt /Sports Kit/Equipment/ Grants/ Workshop

At present 28 residential and 104 Day Boarding Sports centre are running in different districts of the State. Here, apart from residential sports training, the students are provided financial help for their Education/Meal/Sports Kits/Insurance/Medical & other expenses as well as their residential accommodation. The department has provided NIS Diploma coaches for Residential centers and BPED/ MPED/ MPHILL/EX. National & International players qualified coach for day boarding sports centers. We are also planning to appoint sports coaches for new sports centers. A talent search programme is also being carried out by the department for selection of young promising sports person of 9-14 years for these centers. For this scouting is also done in the rural areas. The State government provides sports material/Equipments to different Residential & Day Boarding sports training centers of the State for sports activities. Sports Material/Equipments are also provided to different sports associations. The purpose of this scheme is to a make game popular upto village level and this would bring new talented players in limelight.

3.3 Youth Activities (Youth Affairs)

Jharkhand being a poor state youths do not get adequate opportunity for training in professional & vocational courses. At present the Labour Welfare department runs ITIs in different places. However there are many professional avenues which are not covered by the Labour department. Sewing, shoemaking, handicrafts making, fashionable goods preparing, fire works, Food processing unit etc. are a few to be mentioned. The department proposes to open up small economic ventures at remote places to train the youths and the department shall also sponsor candidates to such professional training centers.

3.4 Organizing International / National / State / District / Block & Other Sports Competition

For promoting Sports activities the State government supports in organising State level National as well as International Competitions in the state. The department organises State school level competitions, Subrato Mukherjee Cup Football, Nehru Hockey Tournament, different school sports competition, C.M. cup & S.M Cup Football Tournament as well as Women sports festival or games every year, so that new talent should come out. Special training camps are organised for these talented players, so that they may bring glory to the state.

The department provide assistance to different sports association for these regular sports activities. They are provided fund for organising training camps/competition and for participating in National/International competition.

3.5 Sports Authority of Jharkhand

For development of sports, Sports Authority of Jharkhand has been established. This Authority will make comprehensive programme for development of sports like organizing different competitions, procurement of sports equipments, sports publications of National/ International standards and developing a good library of sports. We will need fund to meet establishment of the authority also.

3.6 Preparation/Organisation of National Games: 2204

Inspite of several dates to hold the National Games, it was not organized in the financial year 2009-10. So the Budget provision for 2009-10 is being surrendered. In Financial year 2010-11, keeping future possibility to organize the National Games, budget provision is made for.

3.7 Stadium and Sports Infrastructure at district / block level

Jharkhand has immense sports talent. Due to lack of sports infrastructure in every district young sports person suffer a lot of hardship. To mitigate this problem 68 outdoor and indoor sports stadium are under construction in different districts and block levels. Apart form construction of stadiums play fields (at least three sports play fields in a block) are being constructed.

3.8 Astroturf Hockey Stadium Maintenance & Electricity Bill

Hockey is suppose to be one the most favourite games of the rural Youth. The players have now been provided with Astroturf Hockey Stadium of International level so that they can improve their games-skills. The monthly expenditure on

electricity bill will be paid under this head. The monthly expenditure on electricity bill will be paid under this head.

3.9 Construction of Sports Hostel at Sports Training Centre

At present there are 23 residential sports training centers. It is planned to open at least one residential sports training centers in each district. These Residential Sports Training Centers are attached with schools. For developing the modern sports training centres “Sports Hostels” are being constructed. AT present for 5 sports hostels are under construction. Construction of sports hostel for residential sports centres is being processed.

3.10 Security & Maintenance of Birsa Munda Stadium & Payment of Electricity Bill

Birsa Munda Stadium, Morhabadi is being constructed for football. The Stadium can accommodate 3500 people at a go. The old block of Birsa Stadium has been allotted for 34 years lease to the Sports Authority of India. The rest of the Stadium shall remain under State government. 4 High Mast Lights have been installed. Basically the Stadium needs day to day maintenance and proper security system. Monthly consumption of electric bill will be paid under aforesaid head.

3.11 Security & Maintenance of Mega Sports Complex & Payment of Electricity Bill

Compared to the other complexes of sports complexes of India this is one of the best complex in India. It comprises of 11 independent Stadia with practice tracks and warm up areas. The present plan of Mega Sports Complex needs adequate security provision. A public road passes through the Stadium, from Hotwar Jail to villages. The Stadium Complex is fully exposed to this road. So a Boundary wall along both sides of roads has been constructed with gates with entrances to the Stadium Complex. Practice & warmup areas for Volleyball, Basketball, Handball, Wushu, Judo, Karate, Wrestling shall have to be constructed. Permanent watch towers along the boundary of the complex shall have to be constructed.

Building for permanent Police Station for security concern is necessary, therefore pass system has been introduced for entering in to the complex. Regular maintenance of Swimming Pool shall have to be done in addition to other day to day maintenance in all the Stadia. Maintenance & Security system shall be out sourced. Consumed monthly electric bill regarding Mega Sports Complex will be paid under this specific head.

3.12 Organization of National Games

To hold up the National Games 2007 the necessary infrastructure upto international mark in which main stadium, three indoor stadiums, Tennis court, Aquatic complex, Velodrome, Shooting range etc. have been completed. As the games was not held up in 2009-10. It is proposed to budget provision during FY 2010-11 for unforeseen items in infrastructure unit.

Arts & Culture

3.13 Grant to Govt. Cultural Organizations

Training and research organizations like Sarikela Chhau Dance Centre, Manbhum Chhau Dance Centre, Jharkhand Kala Madir have been created formulated and these organizations are already imparting regular training in cultural subjects very successfully.

3.14 Cultural Welfare Schemes

To provide proper protection help and inspiration to the artists and youth of the society certain cultural welfare schemes have been taken up e.g. Welfare fund / Cultural honour, providing traditional instruments and costumes for cultural organization, establishment of statues of great personalities for inspiration.

3.15 Organizing Cultural Programmes

Several Cultural programmes are organized annually throughout the country including our own State by the Department. Some of such programmes are Janjatyia and Kshetriya Mahotsav, Inter State Cultural Exchange Programmes, Sangeet Karyakram. Sahitya Protsahan, Cultural Research and Documentary film making etc. Shrawni Mela a special programme is being organized every year in Deogarh / Dumka.

3.16 Cultural Grants in Aid / Training / Consultancy

A number of cultural NGOs are working in different parts of State where in the present circumstances the Department Infrastructure is not available. So such NGOs are sanctioned grants under the relevant financial rules to continue the cultural activities in remote areas also.

3.17 Development of the Museums and Cultural Awareness

Museums of the State Governments require development in term of display, purchase of equipment and antiquities. Research libraries form an integral part of the museum. Heritage awareness programmes are for the conserving our precious heritage and imparting knowledge to students and rural population.

3.18 Archaeological Activities and Schemes

Archaeological Excavation has been taken up at Khukhragarh (Ranchi) and it is continuing.

The department has taken up survey of all the districts of the state one by one and then main archaeological monuments and sites will be declared protected. 154 archaeological sites and monuments have been listed. Documentation work of about 150 monuments will also be carried out. Conservation work of ancient monument is being taken up. Archaeological Training / Workshop / Awareness programs are also being continued with the help of universities and schools, and consultancy services also are being taken. Besides, Archaeological researches and publications are also continuing.

3.19 Construction of Cultural Building

All the cultural activities take place in auditoria. But no well equipped auditorium is available in most of the Distt. Headquarters even. So, funds are provided to Distt. Adm. for construction of Cultural Centre (auditorium) if they offer land for the purposes, free of cost. In course of conserving the cultural tradition, it is necessary to construct, preserve, develop such cultural centers in rural, as well as urban areas.

3.20 Construction of Museum Building

Site for construction of museum building at the Dumka had also been finalized and the land has also been transferred in the name of the Deptt. It's drawing/map is also being prepared.

To promote cultural activities in the state, the Department plans to construct at least one multi-purpose cultural centre in every district headquarter under state plan scheme. The M.P.C.C. at Ranchi is completed for which there is need of fund to meet its maintenance and security needs.

The State Museum at Ranchi has been inaugurated. Now, there will be need of fund to manage its security, maintenance and day-to-day- activities etc.
