HOME (JAIL)

INTRODUCTION

There are 26 (Twenty-six) Jails including 3 (Three) Central Jails, 19 (Nineteen) District Jails and 4 (Four) Sub-jails in the State of Jharkhand. To ameliorate the pathetic condition of the prisoners due to overcrowding leading to health and sanitation problems, a new Central Jail at Hotwar in Ranchi of the capacity to imprison 3325 male and 100 female has been constructed and made functional. Further District Jail at Ghaghidih in Jamshedpur with a capacity of 1447 prisoners has also been constructed and has been made functional. Open Jail at Hazaribagh apart from Five new sub jails at Nagarutari, Ramgarh, Barhi, Hussainabad and Madhupur are in the process of construction. Two new District Jails at Deoghar and Latehar and Sub Jails at Chandil, Bundu and Chakardharpur have been sanctioned and are in process of land acquisition. The existing capacity of the jail is also being increased by the construction of 54 additional prisoner's ward out of which 22 wards have been made functional. The provision of **Lightening Conductors** and **Water Harvesting** facilities in the prison buildings has been proposed in this financial year.

Security aspect of the prisons, due to the upsurge of Naxal activities has been upgraded and strengthened by providing facilities like E-governance (PMS), Video Conferencing, Barbed Wire Fencing (including consentina), Morcha, Police Barrack, Portable Huts, Close Circuit T.V., Watch Towers, Metal Detectors etc. Further Mobile Jammers, Solar Power Fencing, provision of sophisticated arms, computerized interview system (VMS) with baggage, scanning X-rays machine has been proposed in 2010-11. Further correctional activities like Yoga, Meditation, Literacy and Educational Programmes, Vocational/ Industrial Training, Library etc. are being undertaken. Upgradation of Medical facilities, facilities for jail staff (including mobile sets/ laptop to officers) sanitation and water supply, complete renovation of age old historical prison like Loknayak Jaiprakash Narayan Central Jail, conversion of District Jail Sakchi, Jamshedpur to Women's Jail, upgradation of the Jail Training Institute, Hazaribagh, upgradation of district Jails at Daltonganj and Jamshedpur to Central Jails etc. has also been included in the state plan 2009-10. The use of non-conventional Energy system like solar lamps, solar heaters, solar power stations, solar energy based kitchen apart from Bio-Gas (Human night soil based) etc. are also being proposed in the state plan 2010-11. Further

for the dire need of the vehicles for Jail Inspectorate and field officers of the Jail Department.

Objective

Annual Plan (2010-11) has been prepared keeping multidimensional approach for the overall development of prisons, taking into account correctional as well as Human Right provisions. The objective is to provide sufficient accommodation, adequate water and sanitation facilities, health care, security and correctional activities, and also to optimally use E-Governance non-conventional energy in the Management of Prisons.

2. STATE PLAN SCHEMES

Continuing Schemes

2.1 Completion of New Jails

The Construction of New Jails at (1) Ramgarh, (2) Nagarutari, (3) Husainabad, (4) Barhi, (5) Madhupur and Open jail at Hazaribagh are going on and in progress. Additional funds for the completion of above mentioned jails and for Water Supply, Electrical Installation is required due to increase of estimated cost and the original value which will be provided in the annual plan 2010-11.

2.2 Completion of Staff Quarters

The completion of staff quarters in the different jails of the state are in progress. So, additional funds for the completion of these staff quarters are required and hence are included in the annual plan of 2010-11.

2.3 Completion of Additional Wards/ Perimeter wall

To solve the problem of overcrowding additional wards/ perimeter wall/ prisoners cells are being constructed in different jails of the state, for which additional fund is required in the annual plan 2010-11.

2.4 Sanitation/ Water Supply/ Electrification etc.

Completion of sanitation/ water supply/ electrification/ upgradation of kitchen work:- Upgradation of sanitation/ water supply/ electrification in different jails of the state is necessary for which more fund is required in the annual plan 2010-11.

2.5 Security of Main Gate of Jail/ Solar Fencing/ Installation of CCTV

Requirement of additional fund for installation of CCTV, Cell Phone Jammers and Metal Detectors in the jails of Jharkhand State.

New Schemes

2.6 Non-conventional Energy (Solar/ Bio Gas based Projects)

- Installation of solar fencing units
- Installation of solar lightning / lights/ heaters/ power packs etc.

2.7 Constructions of Boundary wall of Old Central Jail, Ranchi

Prison Inspectorate is running in T.A. Building of H.E.C. only in four rooms. The space of the office is inadequate. Hence independent building of more space is necessary for Prison Inspectorate.

2.8 Provision of Security related equipment installations

- Barbed wire fencing/ Morcha/ Police Barrack/ Watch Tower.
- Solar power fencing.
- Provision of sophisticated arms like INSAS / SLRS in Prison Armory.
- Baggage X-ray Scanning system.
- Door frame/Hand Held Metal Detectors /Searchlights.

2.9 Construction of New Jails

The construction of new jails at Latehar, Chandil, Bundu, Chakardharpur and Chatra has been sanctioned and land acquisition for the same has been proposed. Hence funds are required for the construction of above mentioned new jails, which will be provided in the annual plan 2010-11. The system of water supply & electrical installation in all these jails is also required & hence the funds.

2.10 Construction of Staff Quarters

The construction of staff quarters in all the newly constructed jails and construction of additional staff quarters at the existing jails of the state are required. Hence fund required for same has been provided in the annual plan.

2.11 Construction of Additional Wards/ Perimeter wall

The construction of additional wards/ perimeter wall are required in the different jails of the state, for fund which will be allotted for in the said plan apart from expansion of female wards and enclosure in the jails.

2.12 Sanitation/Water Supply/ Electrifications

- Independent Water Supply through Deep Drilled Boring with overhead tank facility in the jails of Jharkhand.
- Upgradation of sanitary facilities including toilets, urinals, bathing platforms, drains etc. specially in the jails of Jharkhand.
- Renovation of electrical installation in the jails of Jharkhand.
- Upgradation of kitchen facilities including installation of Steam Cooking System in the jails of Jharkhand.
- Provision of Bio-Gas facilities in the jails of Jharkhand

2.13 Renovation of Jails/ Jail Training Institute

- Special Renovation/ expansion of the existing jails of the state.
- Construction/ Renovation of Administrative Block in existing and newly upgraded District Jails and Sub Jails of the state.
- Jail Training Institute, Hazaribagh requires upgradation so that regional status may be accorded and infrastructure for training facilities for Superintendent, Jailor, Assistant Jailor, Clerk & Head Warder and Warders may be imparted. Construction of residence of the Principal, Jail Training Institute, Hazaribag.
- Construction /Renovation/ Expansion of prison infrastructure of all 26 prisons.

3.14 Upgradation of Probation Services/Offices

- Construction of Principal Probation Offices/ Probation Offices including residence of probation staffs.
- Upgradation of fourteen Sub Divisional Probation Offices to District Probation Office.
- Upgradation of Bostral School situated at Daltonganj with installation of infrastructure facilities for vocational/ industrial training and educational facilities for the young convicts.

3.15 Drinking Water purifying unit

With the objective to provide Humane condition to the inmates, safe and pure drinking water facilities by the installation of Purifying Water unit (R.O. System) in all jails.

3.16 Installation of Sewerage Treatment Plant

To provide adequate sanitation facilities, it is proposed to install Sewerage Treatment Plant in the jails of Jharkhand with the provision of Bio-gas facilities. It is proposed that the STP will be undertaken by the Water and Sanitation Department and Bio-gas facilities by Jharkhand Renewable Energy Development Agency (JREDA).

3.17 Construction of Boundary Wall of Prisons

To strengthen the security aspect of the prisons and prison personnel apart from demarcation of the property line of the prisons premises, the construction of boundary wall of the prison premises has been included in the Annual Plan- 2010-11.

3.18 Land Acquisition for New Jails

Land acquisition for new jails to be constructed at Chandil, Bundu, Chatra, Chakardharpur, Husainabad & Latehar are required. Hence the fund is necessary which is included in the annual plan of 2010-11.

3.19 Installation of Lightning Conductor

Installation of lightning conductor in different jails of state will be taken over in the annual plan of 2010-11 for which fund is required.

3.20 Renovation and installation of Jail Industry/ Vocational Training & Teaching

Provision for renovation and installation of jail industry/ vocational training & teaching of prisoners etc. has been made for the jails of Jharkhand state.

HOME (POLICE)

Introduction

Police Modernization (Centrally Sponsored) Scheme has been implemented for the last 8 (eight) years after the formation of Jharkhand in 2000.

Weaponry

Jharkhand Police requires to equip the newly created 90 Police Station forces including naxal affected areas and 20 Assault Groups under STF with quality weaponry on priority basis. The process of recruitment has started. Members of Assault Groups are to be selected from amongst the physically fit and trained constables/havildars of existing force of District Police and Jharkhand Armed Police which is under process. The vacancy so caused for the concerned units would be filled up by fresh recruitment which requires weaponry. Presently it is projected only a portion of the total requirement. It is proposed to acquire new weapons and ammunition.

Mobility

The mobility scenario of Jharkhand Police has improved to a great extent. The state still requires different type of vehicles for newly raised Assault Groups and newly created PSs and other forces. Over and above the routine vehicles for the police units like police stations, circle inspector offices, SDPO offices, District SP offices, DIGs and IGs offices, as well offices at the headquarters like CID, Special Branch, JAP and the police HQRT. some special type secured vehicles are required for movement of force and VIP's. Some of these requirements have been met by the state funds in the year 2009-10, but there continue to be deficits because of newly created force as well as large scale presence of manpower in all police stations and other police units, especially in the naxal affected areas which necessitate Bullet protected LMVs like Rakshak. Further, Jharkhand police has also to factor in the wear and tear and phasing out of vehicles which have run their course as per police manual requirements as well as the damage to vehicles due to accidents and landmine incidents etc.

Office Accommodation

For the year 2010-11, under CSS Jharkhand Police proposes allotment for these ongoing schemes so that the CPWD can complete the construction of police lines at Latehar, Lohardaga, Koderma & Giridih. All these districts are naxal infested and hence require to be completed as early as possible.

Security equipment

Jharkhand Police plans to concentrate funds under this head towards purchase of only BP Jackets and BP Helmets for troops deployed in the naxal affected areas in order to ensure BP coverage of maximum number of personnel. Accordingly the procurement of 2500 BP Jacket/ 2500 Helmet kit is proposed.
