ANNUAL PLAN - 2009 -2010

INTRODUCTION

The Department aims, on one hand to promote the sports & other youth activities to harness the youth power of excellence character, on the other hand it is also responsible for preserving and promoting the tremendous diversity and richness of cultural heritage and ethics of the State. These twin tracks of mental and bodily characteristics focused for enriching the social, cultural and intellectual life of the youth of the state.

The state has a unique and glorious sporting tradition. Apart from being a great treasure of talent for archery, hockey, athletics, kho-kho and football. It was also home to the celebrated hockey wizard and captain of the first Olympic Gold winning Indian team at Amsterdam, Jaipal Singh Munda. The state has also the glory of being the home land of captain of the Indian Cricket team and Kehl Ratan M.S. Dhoni, as well as Michael Kindo, Helen Soy, Savitri Purti, Sumrai Tete, Paltan Hansda, Jhanu Hansda, Budhwa Oraon and Vimal Lakra.

Sports & Youth Affairs

Different Games competitions are being organised from Panchayat to State level to promote sports. Infrastructure like playfields at the panchayat level and Block/District level stadiums are being constructed including in Ranchi a modern state of the art Mega Sports Complex of International standard is ready to host the 34th National Games to chanalise the youth energy and development of Sports, the Government has approved Youth Policy & Sports Policy as well as sports equipments alongwith other facilities are being provided among B.P.L Youth. Participants at National/International Games are being ensured, so that

youth can be inspired. Youth Festival is being organised for awareness among them to mobilized their positive energy. In the year 2007-08 438 medals has been won by the State sportsman, while in the year 2006-07 only 296 medals has been awarded. For this sake 22 Residential and 52 Day Boarding Centre is running at present. Birsa Munda Award, Jaipal Singh Award , Albert Ekka Award, Award in the name of Freedom Fighter has been started. CM Football tournament has been started from this year.

Arts & Culture

To preserve and to protect the ancient culture and monument of the State, several scheme and programme are in our hand. Last year special tribal festival has been held where 6 to 7 thousands participant from the

different state invited. 159 Akhra and 86 Dumkuriya traditional centre has been formulated. Multipurpose cultural building has been constructed in the Hotwar, Ranchi.

Archaeology

Special survey has been constructed in the district Dumka, Saraikela for the purpose to identify ancient archaeological spots. Sutiya mbhe and Kukragarh conservation works are going on. Archaeological workshop is also organised at the district and the state level.

Museum

For the preservation of archaeological objects & materials and cultural property the departmental museum organizes social exhibition, seminar, lectures etc. in which the knowledge of students and common masses along with an awareness about the history of the state.

Achievements

Jharkhand is a rising star in the field of Sports. Several of its players are now playing for the country, especially in the games of Hockey and Archery. Captain of Indian Cricket Team Mahendra Singh Dhoni is also from Jharkhand.

Sports

- The State Capital Ranchi is hosting the 34th National Games Mega Sports Complex of International standard has been developed. It will accommodate 6000 sports person.
- State team Won 1 Gold, 02 Silver and 02 Bronze in 16th Senior National Wushu Championship Merath (U.P.) in Jan 2008.
- State team Won 01 Gold, 02 Silver and 02 Bronze in 32nd National Yoga Championship, Ranchi, Jharkhand, in Jan 2008.
- State team Won 02 Silver and 01 Bronze in National School Game, Kerala in Jan 2008.
- State Athletics team Boys and girls Won 08 Gold, 02 Silver and Hockey team won 16 silver medal in 38th All India Rural Sports Group - 3 Competitive, Faridabad, in Jan. 2008.
- 04 Men/Women Archers and 01 Boxer have participated in Beijing Olympic 2008 China.
- Special Football (Boys) Coaching camp has been organized in Murma Ranchi in which 50 players are participating.
- State Boys/Girls both teams won 03 Gold medal and 05 Bronze medal in athletics Boys and Girls teams won 16 Gold, and 16 silver

in Hockey, Boys and Girls teams won 04 gold 05 silver and 04 Bronze Medals. Boy team won 12 Gold medals in Basket ball in 2nd National Inter School Sports group.

- 146 students have been given Scholarship for sports.
- Sports hostel is being constructed for 23 residential sports centers in different districts.
- Jharkhand team U/14 & U/17 years boys have been participating in National Subroto Mukherjee Cup football tournament New Delhi.
- Jharkhand team U/15 Boys and U/17 Boys & Girls have been participating in National Nehru Hockey tournament in Hariyana.

Art & Culture

- 159 Akhara and 90 Chumkudias have been constructed to preserve the culture of tribal community.
- Jharkhand Kala Mandir has been registered under Societies Registration Act.1860 to take care of tribal and folk art and it has started training classes in different art forms.
- Cultural exchanges with the state of Jammu & Kashmir have been completed under Inter State Cultural Exchange programme. This year cultural exchange with Rajasthan State has been made and cultural exchange with Orissa is in offing.
- State level Tribal and regional festival has been organized.

Archaeology

- Several unreported sites of great archaeological importance have been discovered in Ranchi, Dumka & Sariakela-Kharsawa. As a result, village to village archaeological survey has been started.

- Several monuments in Sahebganj, Ranchi and Lohardaga districts have been developed.
- Archaeological explorations in Ramgarh, Hazaribagh, Ranchi and Sahebganj districts have revealed many important pre-historical and historical sites.
- Khukharagarh excavation has been started.
- Permission for Megalithic excavation in Ramgarh district has been obtained from the A.S.I., Govt. of India.

Museum

- A photo exhibition “Archaeology through Sky” was organized with the help of Israeli Govt.
- State Museum Building has been constructed at Ranchi.
- Small Museum building is being constructed at Itkhor in Chatra district.
- A Research Library has been established in the Ranchi Museum and is being enriched.

2. STATE SHARE TO CSS

2.1. National Service Scheme [7 : 5]

Under this scheme college students are motivated to participate in social work. This scheme is implemented through Universities/ colleges of the state. For this scheme central and state govt. sanction grants in the ratio of 7:5 respectively for two types of programmes -

- a. Regular activities:** During these activities Rs. 160.00 is spent for each volunteers for regular N.S.S. activities.

b. Special Camps : 50% of total strength of sanction N.S.S volunteers are selected for special camp and Rs. 300 is spent on each volunteer.

C. Under NSS villages/tolas will be adopted and special programme will be organized during 2009-10.

2.2 PYKKA (Panchayat Yuva Khel Kud Abhiyan) {75:25}

This scheme intends to promote sports in the rural areas. Several sports competitions at different levels from the Village Panchayat to the State level will be organized under the scheme. The scheme also envisages to develop sports / play grounds & sports facilities at different levels. Sports equipments will be provided to the needy and deserving sports persons and sports organizations. Under the scheme the *Kridashri* (Coaches) will be provided to the Pykka Centers. More over Pykka sports centers will be established at different levels.

3. STATE PLAN SCHEMES

Continuing Schemes

Sports and Youth Affairs

3.1. Sports Welfare Fund / Stipend / Honour

In the arena of sports, Jharkhand is doing well consistently on the National and International levels. So, it has become our responsibility to extend maximum support to our sports persons through various welfare schemes like Sports Welfare Fund, Honouring Sports persons and Sports Scholarship. Incidentally, due to National Games the sports activities have increased many a fold in our State. So, this amount is needed to be increased.

3.2 For Sports Person Training / Consultancy / Talent Hunt / Equipment

In the area of sports, Jharkhand has a remarkable place on the national sports map. If our sports persons are further provided with proper training and equipments, they will be able to achieve any given goal even at international level. So, the Department is trying to provide maximum training and equipment facilities under the able guidance of famous trainers and coaches to our sports person. Besides the Talent Hunt for sports will also be initiate for the different sports training centers.

3.3 Youth Activities (Youth Affairs)

Under the head Youth Activities there are schemes alike NSS, vocational training to youth, help to youth organization and Youth Festival. Which include the student and non-student youth of our State. This scheme mainly provides opportunities even to our non-students rural youth.

3.4 Organizing International / National / State / District / Block & Other Sports Competition

To encourage the sports persons and also to provide them with the opportunities to improve their skills in the respective sports fields on the international / national / state / district / block level & certain other sports competitions. Such competitions include school games, Nehru Hockey Tournament, Women Festival etc. This scheme has brought many a high ranking sports persons from rural areas to the fore.

3.5 Sports Authority of Jharkhand

For development of sports, Sports Authority of Jharkhand has been established. This Authority will make comprehensive programme for development of sports like organizing different competitions, procurement of sports equipments, sports publications of National/ International standards and developing a good library of sports.

Establishment cost of sports authority of Jharkhand is also funded under this scheme.

3.6 Grants in Aid

To promote sports even in the rural areas properly, it is the demand of the time to reach the remotest area where rural sports persons are trying to improve their sports skills. Under this scheme, we have organized different level competitions; we have encouraged participation of sports persons in State and National level tournament / competitions and also provided grants-in-aid to Sports Organizations and sports equipments etc to several other sports groups.

3.7 Preparation / Organisation of National Games

For the National Games Rs. 24000.00 Lakh has been sanctioned this year out of which Rs. 6000 lakh shall be given to other Departments for activities related to security, Town Beautification at Ranchi, Dhanbad and Jamshedpur and other ancillary activities. After National Games, maintenance of all infrastructures, Electricity bill, its security is of prime importance.

3.8 Stadium and Sports Infrastructure at district / block level

Jharkhand has immense sports talent. Due to lack of sports infrastructure in every district young sports person suffer a lot. If sports infrastructures are provide sports talent upto village level, talents may be recognized in time. In first phase one indoor and outdoor stadium with necessary infrastructure is planned to be constructed at district / block level and sports potential areas. Apart form construction of stadiums play fields (at least three sports play fields in a block) are being constructed.

3.9 Astroturf Hockey Stadium (Maintenance)

Hockey is suppose to be one the most favourite games of the rural Youth. These hockey players have now been provided with Astroturf Hockey Stadium of International level so that they can improve their games accordingly. So the proper maintenance and upkeep of the Astroturf Hockey Stadium is a must.

3.10 Construction of Sports Hostel at Sports Training Centre

At present there are 23 residential sports training centers. It is planned to open at least one residential sports training centers in each district. These Residential Sports Training Centers are attached with schools. For developing the modern sports training centres “Sports Hostels” are being constructed. AT present for 5 sports hostels are under construction. Construction of sports hostel for residential sports centres is being processed.

3.11 Organization of National Games 2007

Further constructions which are still to be completed in relation to the National Games are proposed.

Art & Culture, Archaeology and Museum

3.12 Grant to Govt. Cultural Organizations

Training and research organizations like Sarikela Chhau Dance Centre, Manbhum Chhau Dance Centre, Jharkhand Kala Madir have been created formulated and these organizations are already imparting regular training in cultural subjects very successfully. In the year 2008-09 a sum of Rs.

76.00 lakh was earmarked for these Organizations. Now their activities have expanded manifold, so enhancement in the fund is required.

3.13 Cultural Welfare Schemes

To provide proper protection help and inspiration to the artists and youth of the society certain cultural welfare schemes have been taken up e.g. Welfare fund / Cultural honour, providing traditional instruments and costumes for cultural organization, establishment of statues of great personalities for inspiration.

3.14 Organizing Cultural Programmes

Several Cultural programmes are organized annually throughout the country including our own State by the Department. Some of such programmes are Janjatya and Kshetriya Mahotsav, Inter State Cultural Exchange Programmes, Sangeet Karyakram. Sahitya Protsahan, Cultural Research and Documentry film making etc. Shrawni Mela a special programme is being organized every year in Deogarh / Dumka.

3.15 Cultural Grants in Aid / Training / Consultancy

A number of cultural NGOs are working in different such parts of State where in the present circumstances the Department Infrastructure is not available. So such NGOs are sanctioned grants under the relevant financial rules to continue the cultural activities in remote areas also. Besides for beginning and taking of new schemes consultancy and training is also required.

3.16 Development of the Museums and Cultural Awareness

Museums of the State Governments require development in term of display, purchase of equipment and antiquities. Research libraries foam an integral part of the museum. Heritage awareness programmes are for the conserving our precious heritage and imparting knowledge to students and rural population.

3.17 Archaeological Activities and Schemes

Archaeological Excavation has been taken up at Khukhragarh (Ranchi) and it is continuing. New excavation in Ramgarh district is also being taken up.

The department has taken up survey of all the districts of the state one by one and then main archaeological monuments and sites will be declared protected. 154 archaeological sites and monuments have been listed. Documentation work of about 150 monuments will also be carried out. Conservation work of ancient monument is being taken up.

Archaeological Training / Workshop / Awareness programs are also being continued with the help of universities and schools, and consultancy services also are being taken. Besides, Archaeological researches and publications are also continuing.

3.18 Construction of Cultural Building

All the traditional cultural activities take place in traditional Dhumkudia, Akhras etc. So, in course of conserving the cultural traditions, it is necessary to construct, preserve, develop, renovate such new or existing tradition centers in rural as well as urban areas.

3.19 Construction of Multipurpose Culture Centre

To promote cultural activities in different parts of state the department plans to construct at least one multipurpose cultural centre in every district headquarter through state plan scheme.

3.20 Construction of Museum Building

The construction of museum building at Ranchi is almost complete. Site for construction for museum building at the Dumka had also been

finalized. Construction work will be taken up in coming financial year. Renovation work of some other museums will also be taken up.

New schemes

Sports & Youth Affairs, Stadium

3.21 Govt. Sports Institutes / Organization

Throughout the country a number of sports organizations are being run by different State Governments for proper and fast development of sports in their respective States. These organizations have helped these states to improve their sports quality remarkably on National level. Keeping in view this success story, Govt. of Jharkhand has proposed to establish some new useful sports organizations like Sports Academy and Centre of Sports Excellency National Sports Institute, apart from its already functioning Jharkhand Sport Authority.

3.22 Security & Maintenance of Birsa Munda Stadium

Birsa Munda Stadium, Morhabadi is being constructed for football. The Stadium can accommodate 3500 people at a go. The old block of Birsa Stadium has been given on 34 years lease to the Sports Authority of India. But the rest of the Stadium shall remain under State Govt's management. 4 High Mast Lights shall be installed soon for which 4 rooms has been spared for power system. Basically the Stadium needs day to day maintenance and proper security system has to be established. The stadium maintenance and security shall be out sourced. During events special provisions shall also be done.

3.23 Security & Maintenance of Mega Sports Complex

This complex shall be the best complex in India as on today. It comprises of 11 independent Stadia with practice tracks and warmup areas. The present plan of Mega Sports Complex needs adequate Security provisions.

A public road passes through the Stadium which goes to Hotwar Jail and villages. The Stadium Complex is fully exposed to this road. Hence Boundary wall along both sides of roads shall have to be built with gates along entrances to the Stadium Complex. Practice & warmup areas for Volleyball, Basketball, Handball, Wushu, Judo, Karate, Wrestling shall have to be constructed. Permanent watch towers along the boundary of the complex shall have to be constructed.

Building for permanent Police Station may have to be built. Pass system shall be introduced for entering in to the complex. Regular maintenance of Swimming Pool shall have to be done in addition to other day to day maintenance in all the Stadia. Maintenance & Security system shall be out sourced.

3.24 Heritage Conservation (12th Finance Commission)

Govt. of India has allocated a sum of Rs. 1000.00 lakh at the recommendation of 12th Finance Commission for the period 2006-07 to 2009-10 for the Heritage Conservation of the State.

4. TRIBAL SUB PLAN

A sum of **Rs. 7413.72** lakhs has been earmarked for Tribal Sub Plan out of total proposed outlay of **Rs. 11500.00** lakhs during Annual Plan 2009-10.

5. SPECIAL COMPONENT SUB PLAN

A sum of **Rs. 660.00** lakhs has been earmarked for Special Component Sub Plan out of total proposed outlay of **Rs. 11500.00** lakhs during Annual Plan 2009-10.
